Meeting called to order by Supervisor Harvey with the pledge to the flag.
Roll call taken. Present were Harvey, Russell, Croninger, Northrup and Wylie
Cemetery personnel: Scott Knepple and Nancy DuFour

Discussion held on where we stand on the changes needed to be made to the Ordinance. This is still in the hands of the Planning Commission.

Shavehead Cemetery—road needs to have something done. It was cut too close to some stones and they need to be braced. Also, there are many broken stones. We had received insurance money for these repairs a long time ago. They still need to be fixed. The VA will help with veteran's stones. Replace or repair.

Plum Grove—Veterans stones there also need some repair.

Footing Charges—MTA has advised that all cemetery charges and fees need to be paid to the Township and the township pay the Sexton. In the future, Scott will turn in the money for footers and the township will issue a check to him

The markers for the new rows, especially at Plum Grove, needs to be straightened or replaced with another type of marker.

No changes to be made to opening and closing charges.

Again discussed repair on damaged stones and Scott check the cemeteries to see what ones need to be fixed first. Also, he will let us know about road repair at Shavehead.
