DeLano is the realtor of record for these lots and is asking for help so the new owners can connect to the sewer. The cost of the project will probably run around \$50,000. Who is liable for the cost due to the fact the lots were missed when the mapping was done by Wightman and Associates and not included in the Assessment Roll.
