VESSEL SPEED; BAIR LAKE

Adopted: June 13, 1972

An Ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Porter Township; enacted under the authority of Act 303 Public Acts of 1967 (M.S.A. 18, 1287(17)), being identical to State Administrative Rules filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTER ORDINANCES:

43.001

Definitions. All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be construed and the same meanings as those words and phrases defined in Act 303, P.A. 1967, M.S.A. 18, 1287. (8)

43.002

Speed; towing. Regulation No. 14, Cass County R281.714.10 Bair Lake; hours for high speed boating and water skiing.

1. On the waters of Bair Lake, section 34, town 6 south, range 7 west; sections 2 and 3, town 7 south, range 13 west, Porter and Newberg Townships, Cass County, it is unlawful, between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 10(:00) a.m. of the following day to (a) Operate a vessel at high speed, or (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surf board or other similar contrivance.

43.003

Repeal. All other ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

43.004

Penalty. Violations of this ordinance are a misdemeanor and are subject to the enforcement penalties of the Decimalization Ordinance, ordinance number 27, adopted June 9, 1998. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. The imposition of any sentence shall not exempt the offender from compliance with the requirements of this Ordinance.

Severability. This ordinance and various parts, sections, subsections, provisions, sentences and clauses are severable. If any part of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional or invalid it is declared the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected hereby.

43.006

Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication in the Cassopolis Vigilant.
