VESSEL SPEED; COVERDALE LAKE

Adopted: June 13, 1972

An ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Porter Township; enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967 (M.S.A. 18.1287(17)), being identical to State Administrative Rules R 281.730.6 and R 281.730.7, filed in the office of the Secretary of State on August 26, 1971.

THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTER ORDAINS:

- 41.101** **Definition.** All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be construed and have the same meanings as those words and phrases defined in Act 303, P.A. 1967, M.S.A. 18.1287(8).
- 41.102** **Speed; towing.** On the waters of Coverdale Lake, sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, town 8 south, range 13 west, Porter Township, Cass County, it shall be unlawful to (a) Operate a vessel at high speed, (b) Have in tow or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard or other similar contrivance.
- 41.103** **Repeal** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- 41.104** **Penalty.** Violations of this ordinance are a misdemeanor and be subject to the enforcement penalties of the Decimalization Ordinance, ordinance number 27, adopted June 9, 1998. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. The imposition of any sentence shall not exempt the offender from compliance with the requirements of this Ordinance.
- 41.105** **Severability.** This ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, provisions, sentences and clauses are severable, if any part of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional or invalid it is declared the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
- 41.006** **Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication in the Cassopolis Vigilant. Published June 22, 1972
