### TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF PORTER TOWNSHIP:

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT AN ELECTION WILL BE HELD IN PORTER TOWNSHIP ON TUESDAY AUGUST 4, 2020. THE POLLS WILL BE OPEN FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M.**

Precinct 1      Porter Township Administration Building  
Precinct 2      Porter Township Fire Department

Proposals on the ballot include:

**Renewal Drug Enforcement Millage:** In support of law enforcement, criminal justice, and public safety for the citizens of Cass County, including the area of drug enforcement, prosecution, education and treatment, shall there be approved a renewal of up to .4805 mil levy (Forty-eight and five on hundredths(48.05) cents per thousand (\$1,000) dollars) which may be assessed against the taxable value of real and personal property in Cass County for a period of four (4) years beginning 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023.

**Millage Proposition for Service to Older Citizens:** This proposal will renew the current millage for senior service of 0.9969 mills.

**Medical Care Facility Millage:** Shall there be approved up to a fire tenth (.5) mill levy [Fifty (50) Cents Per Thousand Dollars (\$1000)] In state equalized value of real and personal property in Cass County for a period of five (5) years

**Authority:** Renewal Proposal Southeast Public Safety Authority Fire & EMS Millage (This is a Renewal of millage which will expire with the 2020 tax Levy)

Candidates on the ballot include:

**United States Senator, Representative in Congress – 6<sup>th</sup> District, Representative in State Legislature – 59<sup>th</sup> District, Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff, County Clerk/Register of Deeds, County Treasurer, County Treasurer, County Drain Commissioner, County Surveyor, County Commissioner – 3rd District, Township Supervisor, Township Clerk, Township Treasurer, Township Trustee, and Delegate to County Convention**
