Discussed: Russell read the letter of resignation from the Sexton, Russell made the motion with support from Harman to accept Gail and Gary Levan as the new Sexton, roll call was taken Croninger – yes, Marlow – yes, Harman – yes, Wylie – yes, Russell – yes, they were sworn in and a contract was signed between the Township and Levan’s. Russell has a letter that after approval will be sent to the Lake Associations for the purpose of Bubblers which was approved with one change the change will be made so the letter can be mailed out.

Discussion: DuFour addressed the Cemetery issue of letting Stamp-Davis put her parents stone in a way that is not in accordance with the Ord in place, the board was under the understanding that she would only be able to put the stone the way she wanted if all plots in that section were purchased by Stamp-Davis that way the stone could be put in the middle of all of the plots and would not hinder any other sections. As such the amended motion was not met from the January meeting which was that all 8 plots had to be purchased before the stone could be set the way she wants it, this must be met before the stone can be placed.
