*Discussed: Tom Stamp and Jane Stamp-Davis discussed how to resolve her problem with the oversized monument that she would like put in our cemetery, at a previous meeting the board had determined that she would have to purchase all lots in the section she wants it put on and it has to be in the middle of all lots, her brother Tom would like to also purchase some of the lots, Wylie made the motion with support from Marlow to accept a compromise and Jane will purchase 2 more lots (2 and 7) with the monument being placed in the middle of the 4 and Tom will purchase the remaining 4 lots.*
