Shavehead Lake Weed District: Northrup assessor that is working with the Shavehead Lake Association started the meeting by explaining what they are asking for beginning on the winter taxes the amount of \$60.00 for lakefront properties and \$30.00 for backlots will be added for weed control. It was discussed in length as to why this needs to be done. They currently have Eurasian Watermilfoil, and Starry Stonewort which are both invasive species. This plan is for 5 years, and will be done per parcel and will be reevaluated every year to never to exceed this amount. The weeds are very aggressive and can choke out the water and the fish. Other questions were asked as to if this will in danger the wildlife, pets, and children. The chemicals used will be done through a professional. It was also asked if other methods have been looked into and was answered yes but due how big the lake is. The lake association has been paying for this for the past several years. The next meeting will be set for Saturday May 14 at 1:00 p.m.
